Singing at the Fling Rules & Regulations:

1. Please prepare a song of your choosing, up to 3:00 minutes. You must provide your own music, and music must be instrumental and be on a CD or an iPod. Music should be set to the beginning of the song. No lip-syncing allowed. Contestants may sing a cappella or be accompanied or play a music instrument instead of recorded music. If selected as a finalist, your preliminary audition song is the song you will sing in the finalist round on Saturday, September 2, 2017.
2. Singers ages 7-110 are welcome to audition! Solo singers will compete in three age categories (categories are determined after auditions), and duos/groups will compete in a separate category, regardless of age.
3. Decisions by the judges are final.
4. Finalists will be selected in each age group for the Singing at the Fling competition on Saturday, September 2, 2017.

Saturday, Sept. 2 – Singing at the Fling Finals on the Entertainment Stage on Jackson St., 10:30-2PM.

Monday, Sept. 4 – First place winners in each age group to perform on the Main Stage.

Finals

Time: Finalists must be at the Entertainment Stage off Jackson Ave. by 9:00am for sound checks. Finalists' songs will not exceed 3:00 minutes. Due to time constraints on the usage of the stage, there are **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this time rule. The competition will run 10:30 a.m.-11:45 a.m. on Saturday, September 2, 2017.
