To mark Sunday, September 1 as one of community, partnership and servitude, The National Anthem heard at the Main Stage on Rotary Hill will be led by **Aurora Police Officer Christopher Weaver** and all **proceeds gathered in beverage tent tip jars** from that day will be donated directly to the **Aurora Police Foundation**.

The Aurora Police Foundation was established in 1990 to provide financial resources for special projects outside the typical budgeted programs of the Aurora Police Department. Since its establishment in 1990, the Police Foundation has awarded numerous grants to serve health and safety issues in the community.
