Originally from Detroit, Issac Ryan Brown got his big break at the age of six when he auditioned for America's Got Talent and Howie Mandel labeled him a "superstar." Since then, Issac has been consistently working in film, television, commercials, and voiceovers. Issac has recurred on shows such as **Blackish** and **How To Get Away with Murder**. His voiceover credits include **Bubble Guppies** and Miles from **Tomorrowland**. Issac's film credits include Clarence Joseph in the feature film **Believe** and Shawnte in Halle Berry's film **Kings**.

Currently, you can see Issac starring on Disney Channel's hit series, **Raven's Home** alongside Raven Symone as Booker, her son. Season 3 debuted June 17, and features significantly more music than previous seasons. "We have a whole 10 episode arch about our new group Chi-lectives," Issac explains. "So you can expect a lot of laughs; a lot of fun, and definitely whole lot more trouble." The Chi-lectives includes Booker, Nia (Navia Robinson) and Tess (Sky Katz) with Levi (Jason Maybaum) serving as their video director.
